



Elf and Fairy Party- Information Sheet

Thank you for your interest in coming along to the Elf and Fairy Party - A themed woodland activity session designed for children aged 2-6 years together with a parent or carer. My name is Charlotte Atkinson and I am a qualified Level 3 Forest School leader and trainer and run Forest School and woodland activity sessions in my small, private woodland for children and adults. I am an experienced primary teacher and was a primary school headteacher for 6 years before becoming a Forest School Leader.

What will happen during the session?

This is a structured activity session and will include games and activities for you to do with your child as part of the group, e.g. making wands and fairy dust, searching the woodland for signs of little people and making fairy houses and gardens.

Where will the session take place?

The session will take place at Charlotte's Wood in the village of Wilby. The address is Sundial Cottage, London City Road, Wilby, IP21 5LT. There is limited parking at the venue so if possible please park at Wilby Coronation Hall, **on London City Road (IP21 5LE) and then walk 400m up London City Road (away from the village). We are on the left, just past 'The Shingles'.**

When will the session take place?

The session is on Monday 12th August 2019 from 10am - 12pm.

What do we need to wear?

Parents and children are invited to come dressed as an elf or fairy for the session but please make sure that legs and arms are covered (to protect you and your child from stings, bites and scratches) and that a pair of sturdy shoes or boots are worn (no sandals or open toes!). Please bring waterproofs in case it's a damp day.

What do we need to bring?

Any medication that you or your child need. A drink and snack will be provided - please let me know if there are any special dietary requirements.

What about photos?

You are welcome to take photos of your child. Please ask other parents/ carers for permission before taking photos of them/ their child during the session.
